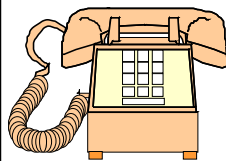

*There were also many 2010 ICD-9 changes effective
October 1, 2009, which impacted general surgery
practices. We will go over these changes.*

- Two tissue transfer codes for increased surface area were added. Definition and limitations were also revised.
- Over 80 new and revised codes for soft tissue tumors were added. Learn what has to be documented in the operative reports in order to bill these codes correctly.
- New codes were added for AV fistula angiography
- Varicose vein codes were revised
- Fistulas, hemorrhoids, and anal procedures. Most codes were revised. Learn all of the updates.
